This is a virtually flawless vehicle, inside, out, and underneath. Appears unrestored original, no physical evidence of collision or refinishing. No modifications of any kind noted.

Paint is extremely high quality, showing no flaws. Appears to be original factory paint. No dings, scratches or open chips noted. One or two touched up chips. Gloss is impeccable. Color appears correct, uniform, and true-to-factory standards. Chrome details are as new, no deterioration noted.

Interior is excellent – near new. Dash is perfect. Center console and shifter are excellent, slight scuffing on console compartment lid (forward of shifter). Shifter knob and boot show no flaws. Steering wheel shows no flaws, finish is burnished to a slight gloss indicating normal use consistent with 41,000 original miles. The carpet and headliner perfect and clear. No foul odors or smoke odors. Interior hardware, door switches and handles are as-new. Seat leather is as-new, except for driver's front seat which shows normal stretching and slight burnishing consistent with mileage. No cracks, scratches or splits in leather. Two sets of floor mats appear to be provided with the vehicle. The set that is installed has moderate wear at driver's foot area, at accelerator.

Glass is perfect all around. Windshield has no wiper marks, no stars or cracks, no sand blasting pitting.

Tires are a matching set of Michelins in new condition.

Wheels appear original and never restored. They are in very good condition however not perfect.

LF: 6/10 coating delamination, no rash LR: 7/10 coating delamination, no rash

RF: 8/10 small scuffs which \*may\* polish out, no rash

RR: 9/10 slight flaws, no rash

Wheel center caps are uniform all around, slight corrosion/delamination at perimeter. Under hood and underbody appear virtually new, no indications of being driven in winter conditions. Engine and engine compartment is extremely clean.

Car started and ran normally, as-new. No vibrations, noises or knocks noted. Car was

not test driven.

AC & amp; fan: normal

Defrost: normal Vent (face): normal Heat (lower): normal

Radio: functioned. No FM signal in garage location. Not fully tested

Fog lights: normal

Power mirrors: normal L&R Power windows: normal, all 4

Exhaust system appears correct and in virtually new condition.
