



This is a virtually flawless vehicle, inside, out, and underneath. Evidence of a recent professional restoration. Concours quality.

Paint is extremely high quality, showing no flaws. Gloss is impeccable. Color appears

correct, uniform, and the metallic content appears correct and true-to-factory standards.

Bodywork is laser straight.

Chrome is show quality, perfect condition all-around. Exception is a very slight dent in

the passenger side rocker molding, visible when the car is raised, about 3" forward of

the wheel well, at the very bottom of the rocker panel. No body damage is evident.

Interior is show quality showing no wear. Dash and center console are particularly nice.

The carpet and headliner are exact reproductions and identical to factory in finish and

fit. Interior hardware, door cranks and handles are perfect, show quality. The driver's

door sill plate has minor, light scuffs from exit and entry. There is a hairline crack in the

dash pad just above the glove compartment that appears to be repairable. The seat and center console armrest vinyl are slightly warped at the piping, and the feel and finish are exact to factory. It is possible that the seats, console armrest vinyl, and door

panels are factory originals, not reproductions. The steering column extension at the steering wheel has a few minor paint flaws but appears original and unrestored.

potentially factory original interior components speak to the likelihood this vehicle was in

excellent condition throughout its existence, even before restoration.

The non-tinted glass is perfect all-around, and is correctly coded. An exception is surface scratches on both halves of the rear window. Likely from the use of metal ice scrapers during its winters in Ohio.

Tires are non-factory gold-wall radials in new condition. Wheelcovers are flawless.

Underhood and underbody detailing is outstanding, high-quality work with virtually no

deterioration due to age. Remarkable attention to detail includes the correct slight

overspray from the heads to the intake manifold, and engine paint on the heater bypass

hose at the timing cover. The engine paint is oversprayed onto the bellhousing, as correct from the factory. Coded paint markings are evident on the suspension components which are clean and correctly finished. There appears to be a factory grease pencil code on the passenger side floor pan visible from underside. Extremely minor battery acid damage is evident at the battery tray and adjacent frame rail, visible

from underside. This is isolated and easily correctable.

Exhaust system appears correct and in virtually new condition.

Car was test-driven by the salesman for about 5 miles with the appraiser in the passenger seat. The engine ran as-new, and there are no body vibrations or rattles. Sensation is that of a factory-new 1963 Corvette. The transmission sound and operation were correct and not indicative of any issues. No flaws in performance were noted.

Lights and accessories were checked. Heat and fan were operational. Headlight doors

were operational. The correct AM-FM radio appeared to have power (crackle in speaker heard) but no broadcasts either AM or FM were picked up. Non-functional. No fluid leaks identified.

Photographs are provided of VIN tag, trim tag, engine VIN, transmission codes and alternator codes. No head casting numbers were visible during this inspection.

Additional observations: overall this is a stunning, no-excuses vehicle of extremely fine quality throughout.
